

THE 58th DUBLIN SCULLING LADDER

2024-2025

The opening Time Trial for the 58th Dublin Sculling Ladder will take place on **Saturday, 12 October 2024**. As usual it will be raced in eight sections, starting on the hour from 10.00 am to 5.00 pm. Participants must check in with Secretary at the Garda Boat Club half an hour before the first section they wish to race. They will be issued with a number, which must be worn visibly on the sculler's back when racing. Scullers wishing to race more than once should retain their numbers until after their last race.

In a slight change this year, scullers must pre-declare which section(/s) they wish to race in. This is to facilitate the timing system. Changes to section pre-declarations entries can be made up to 30 minutes prior to each section start.

Numbers should be returned to the Secretary after each sculler's last race. **Please note that scullers without numbers and scullers who are not pre-declared for a section will not be timed.** No one should use a number issued to another sculler. In the final order scullers who scull more than once will be credited only with their fastest time.

Again, we ask all **club captains** to help with the running of the event by providing responsible people on the bank on bicycles to help to ensure safe and fair racing. Each club will be responsible for the safety of their own scullers. Juniors and inexperienced scullers must be supervised from the bank by members of their own clubs.

Each Section starts from the Telegraph pole (aka 'wires'), just above Trinity Boathouse, and finishes at the end of the towpath at Chapelizod. Scullers should be reminded that when they have finished racing, they **must not impede** those who started behind them who are still on the course. Scullers should keep their bows upstream while waiting above the finish until they are instructed to turn and come down river.

The winner wins the Wooden Goblet, the Fastest Woman wins the Yew Goblet. There are also prizes for the fastest junior man and woman. Each club's top eight scullers score for the team trophy, the Steve Casey Memorial Cup. Last year's winners are asked to return the trophies cleaned and with the inscriptions up to date.

Good racing to all in this 58th Time Trial. Results and Presentations in the Garda Boat Club on race day at 7 pm.

Racing by Challenge Races will continue in the 58th Dublin Sculling Ladder until the last Saturday in March 2025.
